Jill played a leading role in the introduction of tactile paving at pedestrian crossings and low floor buses. Jill recently persuaded the DWP to introduce a password scheme so that visitors to vulnerable households can prove who they are, after a 40 year campaign. In recognition of her lifetime of voluntary work, Jill was awarded the MBE in 1983 and the OBE in 2012.
